### STOP PRESS! A22LS Amphibian at Temora



Come and see the new A22LS Amphibian at Natfly Airshow at Temora over the Easter weekend! Our blue A22LS amphib is the first LSA float plane amphibian to be registered in Australia. Floats are the highly respected FPNA 'Waterbourne' float system with pneumatically retractable wheels. Floats are a mixture of Kevlar and e-glass with 7 watertight chambers and a dry stowage bin in each float.

### Basic data

- empty weight around 385 kgs
- MTOW 650 kgs
- usable 265 kgs
- take-off on water, around 150 metres
- land on water around 80 metres
- maximum wave height (experienced pilot) 2-3 feet
- cruise at a genuine 90 kts

This is one impressive aircraft - come and see it and the land-plane A22LS Foxbat on stands 5 & 6 at Temora, NSW, on Friday 2nd and Saturday 3rd April.
